

No Strings Theatre COVID-19 Protocol

As an online 9-day development project, No Strings Theatre will be complying with the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020*, SO 2020, c 17. We intend to comply with all guidance from the Government of Ontario and Toronto Public Health to protect to safety of our emerging artists. As an online developmental project, guidance suggests no additional procedures need to be adopted at this time as none of our emerging artists will be gathering in one space.

If the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act*, allows for in-person filming for the eventual presentation of the developmental project, No Strings Theatre will comply with all municipal, provincial, and federal guidance and public health orders to ensure a safe and healthy environment for our emerging artists.

In this in-person component, No Strings Theater will ask the following screening questions:

1. If the individual has any COVID-19 or symptoms
2. If the individual has travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days
3. If the individual has had close physical contact with a person confirmed positive within the past 14 days identified by a Public Health Agency.
4. If the individual has been partially or fully vaccinated. If vaccinated to provide vaccination dates.

No Strings Theatre will provide Non-Medical Masks and Hand Sanitizer during the in-person components to the emerging artists in the event physical distance cannot be maintained.
